

# ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2010-2011

Dear Parents:

Listed below by grade are the essential school supply items that your child will need for next year. Your generous cooperation in purchasing these items will assist your child greatly in the educational process in the classroom. With each child being properly supplied with these materials, the students will reach their maximum potential. All items listed below are used by the students. - One 2-2 ½ inch zipper binder
