

## MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2009-2010

Dear Parents:

Listed below are the essential school supply items that your child will need for the next year. Your generous cooperation in purchasing these items will assist your child greatly in the educational process in the classroom. With each child being properly supplied with these materials, the students will reach their maximum potential. All items listed below are used by the students. In some cases, such as loose leaf paper, teachers will collect all of the paper and create a classroom supply that all students can access. If you and your family should feel this is a financial hardship to purchase all supplies, please contact the Principal.

### **MIDDLE SCHOOL**

- One 2 -2 ½ inch zipper binder
- Set of six pocket dividers (Label: Homework, Take Home, Religion, Lang. Arts, Science, Social Studies, Math)
- Four boxes of tissues (give to homeroom teacher)
- Two black or blue ball point pens
- Several #2 pencils with erasers
- One package colored pencils
- One package colored markers
- Scissors with sharp points
- Backpack or book bag
- (4) 2 pocket folders labeled – technology, art, Spanish, music
- One 12 inch ruler (with English and Metric measurements)
- A container for art supplies
- Four packets of loose leaf paper (two for your folder; two for your homeroom teacher)
- Combination lock
- Girls – 1 container of antibacterial wipes
- Boys – 1 roll of duct tape

### **Language Arts**

- Three composition books with sewn-in binding (Jump Start Journal, Literature Log, Writer's Notebook)
- Five two pocket folders with three ring holes (for Literature, Essays, Poetry, Book Reports & Sci. Fair)
- Paperback Dictionary
- Paperback Thesaurus

### **Science**

- Four glue sticks (hand into the science teacher)
- Latex or latex free gloves (hand into the science teacher)
- A pair of plastic safety goggles (optional)

### **Social Studies**

- Two pocket folders with 3 ring holes
- 8 pieces of large white poster board
- Miscellaneous items (popsicle sticks, sugar cubes, cardboard, etc.) may be requested throughout the year.

### **Math**

- Geometry set with compass and a small protractor
- One pack of 1cm graph paper (hand in to teacher)
- Two packs of thin dry eraser markers (one to hand in to your math teacher, the other for you to bring with you to class.)
- Scientific Calculator (except for Algebra students)
- Algebra students only – one 4 pack of triple "AAA" batteries (hand in to teacher)
